Prepare the soil by digging to a depth of 10-15cm, rake and level to produce a firm and even surface. If soil is dry apply Yates Waterwise Hose On Soil Wetter to improve vater movement in your soil.

ave area for approximately two weeks or until weeds begin to germinate. Light atering will be required to initiate weed germination. After weeds have germinated, pray the entire area with Yates Zero® Weedkiller spray. This ensures your lawn will not have to compete with weeds for nutrients while establishing, and promotes mproved coverage.

Once the weeds have died off, lightly rake over the area to loosen the soil. First spread

May require watering several times a day in hot or windy conditions. awn should be first mown when it reaches 10cm in height and then gradually reduce o a minimum of 5cm.

BEST SOWING TIMES

For best results sow in early autumn to allow development of a deep root system prior to first summer.

While spring sowings are possible, more watering will be required throughout the first summer.

For oversowing shade or cold-damaged buffalo or kikuyu, sow in autumn or early spring.
